

Product Details



First Time Usage

- 1. Press the power button and a blue LED light will flash around the "Start/Stop" button indicating that the blender can be used.
- 2. The LED light rotates clockwise when the machine is turned on, and the default running time is 20 seconds.
- **3.** If the blender display a flashing red & blue light when pressing the "Start/Stop" button, this means that the safety switch is not detected and the bottle has not been locked in appropriately.
- **4.** If the red light flashes after the "Start/Stop" button is pressed, this indicates that there is an object stuck under the blade and it has entered the overload protection mode.


Instructions On Proper Use

Charging Method:

- Connect your charging brick into a power source.
- Insert the Type-C cable into the USB charging port.
- A red LED light will switch on to notify that the battery is now charging.


Power Indicator:

 While charging, the red LED lights move clockwise from low to high power. After charging is completed, a blue LED light will be displayed.



Startup:

- Hold the Power Switch and the blue LED light will switch on.
- The blender has now entered the standby mode.
- Press the Start/Stop button to switch on the blender, pressing the same button again to turn it off.



Blending Fruits & Vegetables:

- Cut the fruits & vegetables into small pieces (2cm pieces)
- Place the cut fruits and vegetables into the cup. The fruits and vegetables should not be more than 1/2 of the cups capacity)
- Add an appropriate amount of water or milk, ensuring that the liquid is at least 3 fingers length away from the cup mouth.
- Switch on the blender and press the Start/Stop button to begin blending, pressing the same button to stop blending based on your requirements.

Cleaning & Maintenance

- Before cleaning, make sure the blender is switched off and the blades have stopped moving.
- The main base can be cleaned by wiping it with a dry or damp cloth. Never use sharp objects or corrosive liquid solvents to clean the products.
- Clean the blades with a small brush.
- Never touch the blades with your fingers to avoid injury.

Safety Precautions

- It is forbidden to switch on the blender without the lid or when the base is not tightened firmly.
- Do not open the blender when it's turned on for personal safety.
- Never touch the blades with your bare fingers when cleaning.
- Do not use the blender continously when the base is at a high temperature. Let it cool before running again.
- Do not use when any water leakage is found. The product will need to be sent back to the Russell Taylors service centre for repairs.
- The battery must be charged every 3 months or the battery will be permanently damaged. DO not use it continuously for more than 1 minute. Allow the blender to rest in 1 minute intervals after each use.
- Do not place the blender within reach of children.
- Do not allow children to use the blender alone without supervision.
