

Safety Warning Precautions

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, follow the instructions below:


- This device should not be used by children below the age of 8
 years old. Children over 8 years old shall not perform cleaning
 and maintenance operations without supervision from an adult.
- Do not burn the device.
- Do not immerse the device in water or liquid.
- Keep the machine out of reach of children.
- Ensure that children are kept away from the unit while it is powered on.
- Do not expose the device to flame or excessively high temperature, and ensure that the cable is far away from any hot surface to avoid deformation and damage.
- Connect to a properly grounded power outlet.
- Do not leave the device unattended while the power is turned on.
- Do not modify plugs or use damaged power cables or plugs. If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by professional maintenance personnel.
- Unplug the electrical outlet when not in use and before cleaning,
 maintaining or servicing the device.
- Hold the plug of the power cord and pull it out, not the power cord

itself.


- Do not hold the plug of the power cable with wet hands.
- Do not pull or lift the device using the cable.
- Do not use damaged or modified devices.
- Do not clean sharp large debris (glass), hazardous products
 (solvents, detergents), aggressive products (acids, detergents),
 combustibles and explosives (gasoline or alcohol), burning or
 smoking objects (cigarettes, matches, or hot ash) using this
 device.
- Be sure to use the parts provided by the manufacturer.
- Do not let the steam spray directly on people and animals.
- Do not use this device on leather, waxed furniture or flooring,
 synthetic fibers, velvet or other perishable and other steam
 sensitive materials.
- Liquid or steam should not be directed towards a device containing electrical components, such as the inside of an oven.
- Turn off all controllers before unplugging.
- Plastic film can be dangerous, it should be kept away from children to avoid choking.

- If the device has been dropped on the ground, damaged, placed outdoors, or dropped in water and does not work properly, do not attempt to operate it, but take it to an authorized service center for repair.
- Please be sure to use the device in accordance with the instructions in this user manual.




Assemble And Disassembly of Fabric Brush Cover



Assemble And Disassembly of The Bristle Brush Head




Assemble And Disassembly of The Self-Cleaning Cover

3.1 Fabric brush cover cleaning




3.2 Cloth cleaning

Troubleshooting

Common fault	Possible cause	Solution
Machine is not working	The power plug is not fully inserted	Plug in the power
	Use the wrong accessories	Replace accessories
	Dirty water tank is full	Clean the dirty water tank
The machine won't produce steam	Water shortage in the clean water tank	Add water into the clean water tank
	Preheating incomplete (Start/Stop light flashing)	Wait for preheating to complete (Start/Stop light stops flashing)
